DRESS REHEARSAL Information

DRESS REHEARSAL: Friday, May 3 from 3:05-10:15 PM at the Long Center for the Performing Arts located at 111 N. 6th St., Lafayette, IN. The scheduling of this evening is very complex as we try to allow dancers time to get home from school, have our little ones rehearse earlier in the evening, while still giving our numerous dancers who dance in multiple numbers enough time to prepare between their routines.

PURPOSE: The purpose of the dress rehearsal is to allow the dancer a "trial run" of *everything* before the actual performance. This is an opportunity for the dancer to get the feel of the stage, learn where to enter and exit, experience new spatial relationships, look up into the overwhelming number of seats, and get the "jitters" out as much as possible. It is also a time to set lighting as well as evaluate costuming, makeup, hair, etc.

PARKING/ENTRANCES: Street parking is available. We may also use the Columbia City Parking Garage two blocks from the Long Center at 18 North 5th Street, Lafayette with no charge after 6:00 PM and on weekends. The parking lot across the street from the Long Center *cannot* be used! Enter through the front of the building under the marquee.

<u>COSTUME/MAKEUP/HAIR</u>: Costumes should be worn upon arrival (carry in your dance shoes) as well as makeup and hair done. *The week of* **April 22-25** teachers will hold a quick meeting the last 5 minutes of class with parents to make sure everyone is on the same page and answer questions regarding costume, makeup, hair, accessories, etc. We also ask that costumes *not* be worn until pictures, unless it is just to try it on at home for sizing, alterations, etc.

<u>ARRIVAL</u>: Please arrive <u>before</u> your scheduled stretch/transition time with costume on as well as makeup and hair done. Our floor manager will direct you where to go upon arrival. Parents may remain with their dancer throughout this dress rehearsal process if desired; otherwise class escorts will take over.

AFTER REHEARSAL: Dancers are free to go once we are finished on stage rehearsing the routine. Parents may go to the St. John Pavilion, as you will Saturday night, where the class escort will be there with your child.

<u>GUESTS</u>: If you need to bring other children with you the evening of the dress rehearsal, it is important you *KEEP THEM WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES*. As a protection to this beautiful theatre, and the safety of those involved in the "mechanics" of the rehearsal, it is important that we do not have little ones running around.

A FEW FINAL NOTES:

*Please <u>no</u> food or drink in the theatre. Drinking fountains are available. Please bring a t-shirt to wear over the costume when getting a drink should your costume be made of fabric that will water spot. *Leave all jewelry and personal items at home.

*I will have an emergency box of extra hair, sewing, medical items. Should you need something during dress rehearsal or recital, ask your class escort.

Show Information

Show: Saturday, May 4 at 1:00 AND 6:00 PM (house doors open 12:00 PM for the matinee and 5:00 PM for the evening show), at The Long Center for the Performing Arts located at 111 N. 6th St., Lafayette, IN. **ALL Dancers perform in both shows**

PARKING/ENTRANCES: Street parking is available. We may also use the Columbia City Parking Garage two blocks from the Long Center at 18 North 5th Street, Lafayette with no charge after 6:00 PM and on weekends. The parking lot across the street from the Long Center *cannot* be used! Enter through the front of the building under the marquee.

TICKETS: Because our show has become so popular, seating is reserved. Areas in the upper balcony seats will be set-aside for Y-Dance students. Ticket sales will be taken care of through The Long Center of Performing Arts. You must select your own seats. Separate tickets will be sold for each show, as they are at athletic events. Tickets may be purchased in advance online, and over the phone by calling the Long Center Box Office. Please see separate document for details on ticket sales. Tickets go on sale **April 11-18** to Y-Dance families. That week we are limiting tickets to 10 tickets per transaction. Beginning **April 19 at 11am**, when tickets go on sale to the public, you may purchase as many as you want. However, if you need more than 10, please call the box office to complete the transaction. Cost is \$11/adult (ages 13 and older) plus fees and \$6/youth (ages 0 to 12/anyone who utilizes a seat) plus fees. Tickets will also be available at the door prior to the recital at a price of \$13/adult plus fees and \$7/youth plus fees.

All ticket sales are final.

<u>COSTUME/MAKEUP/HAIR</u>: Costumes should be worn upon arrival as well as makeup and hair done. Please carry in your dance shoes. We ask that parents please keep your dancers' personal belongings with them during the show. Please note that hair should be pulled back and away from the face and sprayed well to keep it in place. (Individual classes may have special hairstyle assignments.) We recommend that makeup should be bright cheek color and red lip color, mascara, eye shadow. Performing on a stage and under bright lights can really "wash out" faces. Specific details about costume, makeup, and hair will be determined when costumes arrive and are tried on as a class. Also, a review will be talked about the last 5 minutes of classes the week of **April 22-25**.

ARRIVAL FOR DANCERS:

For the Matinee, please arrive *before* your listed call time. Proceed upstairs to the balcony lobby where class escorts will be waiting to help your dancers. An appointed Y-Dance staff will then bring the class down, if needed, for a run-through. Not all classes will do run throughs. The room is very small for what needs to be accomplished, so unless parents/adults are wearing a volunteer badge, we ask you to be seated in the theatre, relax, and enjoy the show!

For the evening show please be in the theatre no later than 5:30. If your dancer is in the first four numbers, go directly to the dressing rooms. If not, please find your seat in the upper balcony with your escort. Please make sure to touch up their make-up before the second show.

AFTER INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCES/CURTAIN CALL: Each class will be escorted to the upper seating area so our dancers may also enjoy the remainder of the show. **Please do not come to see them, congratulate them, or take them home.** Dancers will have an opportunity to make a final curtain call at the end of each show. If you have a dancer in multiple numbers, they will take their final bow *with all their classes but wearing the last costume in which they performed.* We ask the audience to remain seated until the curtain call is over.

AFTER THE SHOW: Dancers will be taken to the St. John Pavilion by their class escorts and will remain there until a parent arrives. We ask that you wait 10 minutes after the last person has exited the stage before you come get your dancer so we may congratulate them, give hugs, and bid them farewell! A little gift will be given to them after the <u>evening show</u>.

<u>VIDEO TAPING/PHOTOGRAPHY</u>: Recital DVD may be purchased through the link on the packet cover. Cost is \$20. We ask that **NO FLASH PICTURES and videography** be taken while our students are performing. You may pick up your DVD at the YWCA **June 12**.

A FEW FINAL NOTES:

*Please feed your dancer a nutritious and adequate early lunch/dinner before coming.

*If you have a dancer in multiple #'s, a personal assistant will be assigned to your dancer

*Please **no** food or drink in the theatre. Drinking fountains are available.

*Leave all jewelry and personal items at home.

*There will be a box of emergency supplies, sewing and hair needs. Please ask your escort should the need arise.

Arrival times for each class, please do your best to arrive as close to call time as you can. (Please Note: these are not performance times)

2024 Y-Dance Recital Ticket Instructions

Three ways to purchase recital tickets:

- Online (Instructions below)
- Call the Long Center Box Office at 765-742-5664, M-F, 1-4pm
- Paying Cash/Check: Pay on the day of show, Box Office opens May 6th, noon-1pm & 5pm-6pm

Please note: NO tickets will be sold at the YWCA. If you have questions or concerns or trouble with purchasing, please call Long Center Box Office at 765-742-5664, ex.1 for help. The YWCA will NOT be able to help with concerns. Thanks for understanding!

Some fees apply when purchasing tickets. And when using a credit card, you will be charged a convenience fee. Your credit card statement will reflect a charge from "EVENTTICKETSPURCHASED".

To Purchase Tickets Online:

- 1. Go to <u>https://longpac.org</u>
- 2. Click on Y-Dance Show tile: May 4th
- 3. Pick the calendar tile on May 4th
- 4. Then, click the showtime (**1 PM** or **6 PM**) in which you would like to purchase tickets
 - a. If you want to purchase tickets for both shows, you will be able to add the other show when you get to your "shopping cart"
- 5. An access code will be needed for you to go further
 - a. This code will be activated at 11 AM on Monday, April 8th
 - b. Click Add Promo Code
 - c. Enter the Y-Dance Family access code: ydancefan24, then click the arrow to continue
 - d. Tickets will be available to the general public on Friday, April 19 at 11am.
- 6. Choose the number of Adult and/or Youth tickets needed. There is a 10 ticket maximum.
- 7. Click "Add tickets to cart"
- 8. At this point, you have two options: Checkout or Purchase tickets for another show
 - a. If you **checkout**, you have 15 mins to complete the transaction, so have your card information ready
 - b. If you want to purchase tickets for another showtime, then
 - i. Click the calendar event on May 4 "Y-Dance The Eras Recital"
 - ii. Select a showtime, then click next
 - iii. Choose the number of tickets
 - iv. Click "Add tickets to cart" (your access code should remain visible)
 - v. Then proceed to Checkout
- Review your order details, and select **Delivery Method** "Will Call" or "e-ticket" (preferred method)
- 10. Enter the name on the tickets, and click Continue
- 11. You have the option to donate to the Long Center or click Continue
- 12. To complete your transaction, fill out your **Contact Details, Review Your Order,** and enter your **Billing Information**

You have now purchased your Y-Dance recital tickets! And you will receive an email confirmation. Your e-ticket is located inside your confirmation email, click on the blue button, "Ticket Order Details"

If you would like to order pictures, place your order and payment at the time they are taken. *If your order form and checks are completed previously, it will help expedite this process*. <u>Please use a separate order form for each picture</u>. If a family has a dancer in multiple numbers OR multiple dancers, you may make one payment for the total! ⁽²⁾ <u>You need to be sure and bring all forms at the time of your first group, and make sure the forms are marked with the name of each class/routine!</u> Lori can also take credit cards on her iPhone.
